# TRAVEL TIPS

- ▶ Some experiences listed are seasonal and only available at certain times of year. To avoid disappointment, check opening hours before you travel and make bookings where necessary.
- Country roads can be in variable condition with windy or steep sections. Please slow down and drive to the conditions. Look out for wildlife on the roads at dawn and dusk
- Using a GPS? Make sure you get the right directions by entering the name of the town not the area you want to visit (ie Katoomba NOT Blue Mountains).
- If you are planning to bushwalk, always put safety first. Download the National Parks and Wildlife Services app to check for updates on walking track conditions and bushfire danger levels.





Check in at the Blue Mountains Heritage Centre to fill in a trip intention form before you depart. Always check the conditions with the National Parks and Wildlife Service before you set out.

- >> Descend into the Grose Valley on one of the fantastic hiking routes and take home spectacular photos from the scenic lookouts along the way.
- >> See the valley from above on the energetic 6km Clifftop Walk from Govetts Leap to Evans Lookout.
- >> The 7km Lockleys Pylon return walk from Mt Hay Rd, North Leura offers some of the best views in the Blue Mountains.
- >> Walk to Pulpit Rock from Govetts Leap and enjoy several cliff-side lookouts with panoramas over the Grose Valley to distant mountains.
