- Like to know your Sunday morning eggs are good and fresh? Visit the Galeas at Llandilo Egg Farm, which has been family owned and operated since 1963.
- Dip your toe into Penrith's growing craft brewing scene at Rusty Penny Brewing Co, Casey's Brewery or Squinters Brewing Co choose just one, or visit all three!
- Make a trip to Montecatini Meats where decades of experience are distilled in a range of outstanding smallgoods made onsite in the heart of our City.
- Life is sweet, especially when you visit **Pasticceria Dolce Mia** before heading to St Marys for an afternoon sugar lift from Indian and Fijian style sweets at **Princess Nisha's**




Riverside adventure

There's so much to see and do along the banks of the river, it's a real must do for any trip to our City.

Set aside a day, take your time, and soak up the serenity.






On the east side, stop in at the Log Cabin for a drink and lunch or carry on to Tench Reserve where you'll find East Bank and its great restaurants and bars.

Make the **Nepean Naval and Maritime Museum** your next port
of call and immerse yourself in a
fascinating collection of historical
items, displays and documents.

Weir Reserve is a beautiful, quiet spot to enjoy a picnic and views of the river. It's also home to the Japanese Garden which celebrate Penrith's friendship city agreements.

- There are so many ways to explore the Nepean River. Get out on the water with Horizon Line Canoes, take the 6.4km Great River Walk, a loop that leads across the stunning Yandhai Nepean River Crossing or book a cruise on the Nepean Belle Paddlewheeler.
- Make time for a coffee or meal at Emu Hall. This historic home on the western riverbank, has been lovingly restored and is now a popular and picturesque dining spot.
- While you're on the western side of the river, visit the Penrith Regional Gallery Home of the Lewers
 Bequest for a fix of art and culture and a break in the garden café.

- The **Museum of Fire** celebrates the history of firefighting in an accessible building, with accessible displays and toilets, both inside and out near the picnic grounds.




Foodie adventure


















The Blind Chef Café





One of the best ways to explore a new city is to set out on foot, and the Penrith Heritage Walk invites you to do just that as you discover Penrith's present and its past!



From the South

From the South Western Freeway/Hume Highway take the Penrith exit, follow the signs along Northern Road to Penrith, or continue past the Northern Road exit and take the M7 Tollway (e-Toll only*) to the M4 Motorway.

From the North

From the Sydney
Newcastle Freeway or
Pacific Highway follow
Pennant Hills Road and
the Cumberland Highway,
then take the M2 Motorway
which converts to the M7
Tollway (e-Toll only*), then
turn onto M4 Motorway.

From the West

From the M4 Motorway/ Great Western Highway, take the Northern Road or Mulgoa Road exit for Penrith; the Mamre Road exit for St Marys; or the Russell Street exit for Emu Plains.

* If you do not have an electronic tag then it's best to purchase an Emu Pass designed for visitors and casual users of Sydney toll roads. Phone 13 18 65 or visit emupass.com.au

By Public Transport

Penrith is on the Western and Blue Mountains line of the Sydney Trains network. Our local railway stations are St Marys, Werrington, Kingswood, Penrith and Emu Plains.

Trains to the Blue Mountains via Penrith and Emu Plains depart from Central.
Suburban trains depart regularly from Central and City stations. Daily NSW TrainLink services to and from Central NSW also stop at Penrith. If you are travelling to the airport, change at Central for the airport link trains.
